Crufts 2024 tickets released

The world's greatest celebration of dogs returns

Organised by The Kennel Club, Crufts 2024 will run from Thursday and through the weekend with a four-day action-packed schedule celebrating our four-legged friends and all things dog. The event will showcase over 200 diverse breeds and see dogs from all walks of life put their best paw forward in fast-paced and fun competitions including agility, heelwork to music, flyball and obedience.

The family-favourite Scruffts final sees the nation's pets - who earned their place in heats across the country throughout the year - compete for the 'top dog' title and on Sunday evening, one of five very special finalists will be crowned as the winner of The Kennel Club Hero Dog Award, as voted by the public. Shortly after, following four days of competition, one canine Crufts competitor will put their paws on the coveted Best in Show trophy, which in 2023 was taken home by Orca, the Lagotto Romagnolo, whose 'tail never stops wagging'.

Each day will conclude with one dog earning their place in the Best in Show final on Sunday evening, beginning with the Utility and Toy groups on Thursday 7 March, Gundog group on Friday 8 March, Working and Pastoral groups on Saturday 9 March and concluding with the Terrier and Hound groups on Sunday 10 March.

For the 30th year, the popular Discover Dogs area will be welcoming over 200 different breeds, of all shapes, sizes and personalities, enabling visitors to learn more about the variety of our four-legged

friends from breed experts and see which canine might be the right companion for them.

From discovering the lesser known 'underdogs', like the rare Otterhound, to understanding what the popular family-favourites, like the Labrador Retriever, really need in a home, Discover Dogs is a unique area of the event. Each breed 'booth' can help prospective puppy owners on every step of their journey - from responsible puppy buying tips to day-to-day training and caring requirements.

For those hoping to rehome a rescue dog, The Kennel Club Breed Rescue organisations will also be on hand to provide visitors with everything they need to know about rehoming.

After a successful launch of the Stand Up To Cancer Crufts Walkies Challenge in 2023, which saw dogs and their owners raise an incredible £1.4 million, the challenge will be returning for a second year - encouraging two and four-legged friends to walk 60 miles in April to support life-saving cancer research.

Over 500 stands selling all sorts of doggy delights will cover 25 acres of the NEC at Crufts. The event also showcases a range of dog-focussed charities and organisations, including The Kennel Club Charitable Trust, who will demonstrate how dogs can support us, and how we can support them. Many of these organisations will also showcase their work through displays, like the super sniffing Medical Detection Dogs and the brave West Midlands Police Dogs.

The Young Kennel Club, for 6-24-year-olds, and The Kennel Club's Good Citizen Dog Training scheme, will be running displays and demonstrations in dedicated rings throughout the four days. There is also a Dog Activities ring for those interested in learning more about getting

started in activities such as agility, heelwork to music and obedience.

Catherine Guiver, Head of Events at The Kennel Club, which organises Crufts, said: "We are overjoyed to be rolling out the green carpet once again and welcoming thousands of wagging tails to the Midlands."

"It is hard to put into words the unique atmosphere created over four days at Crufts, there really is nothing like the greatest celebration of dogs - the buzz and excitement can be felt the minute you enter the NEC!"

"The action-packed schedule ensures a great day out for anyone who loves dogs, from first thing Thursday morning the energy just continues to build in anticipation of the Sunday evening as the arena seats are filled with everyone trying to get a glimpse of the famous Best in Show trophy."

Over the four days Crufts welcomes over 20,000 dogs, 150,000 people and sees over 8 million TV viewers tune into the Channel 4, More4 and All4 broadcast. All the action is also live streamed on the official Crufts YouTube channel.

Spaniels star in new dog photography exhibition at The Kennel Club Art Gallery

A new photography capsule exhibition by Yorkshire-based artist, dog photographer and owner, Daisy May, has opened at The Kennel Club Art Gallery, showcasing one of the UK's vulnerable native breeds, the Clumber Spaniel.

The collection, which features 12 specially curated images in contrasting settings, celebrates the rich history of the Clumber Spaniel – from carrying out their traditional working activities in modern day field trials, to their role as a family member in the home, and is now open to the public until May 24 2024 at The Kennel Club in London.

A unique highlight of the exhibition is an image commissioned for the Working Clumber Spaniel Society (WCSS) which photographs five Clumber Spaniels standing underneath the historic John Ems painting at The Kennel Club, which was then gifted to HRH Princess Anne as president of the WCSS.

The Clumber Spaniel was once popular among His Majesty King George V, who kept many on the Sandringham Estate. Today, the Clumber Spaniel has fallen from favour in the UK and is one of breeds on The Kennel Club Vulnerable Breeds list, with just 232 puppies registered in 2022.

Daisy discovered photography for the first time in 2017, combining her new interest with her lifelong passion for dogs. Daisy has since spent years photographing for bespoke commissions and capturing the unique character of our loyal canine companions. Having lived with up to six Clumber Spaniels at a time, Daisy wanted to create a collection that brought awareness to the breed as both a skilled dog in the field, and a pet in the home.

A unique highlight of the exhibition is an image commissioned for the Working Clumber Spaniel Society



Daisy commented: "The inspiration for a lot of my dog photography is portraying dogs in relatable settings, whether at home or out and about. I also work to include two main aspects, to capture their characteristics and importantly the bond between dog and owner."

Heidi Hudson, The Kennel Club's curator of photographic collections commented: "We are really excited to be showcasing this collection of photographs which will be a joy to both photography and dog lovers. The Clumber Spaniel, as one of The Kennel Club's Vulnerable Native breeds, is lesser-known to most of us, compared to their popular relations, like the Cocker and Springer Spaniel, so it is wonderful to see Daisy May shining a light on the highly intelligent Clumber."

"I am sure this is the first of many future collaborations with this wonderful photographer."

The exhibition is open to the public at The Kennel Club Art Gallery at 10 Clarges Street, Mayfair, W1J 8AB, from Monday to Friday between 9.30am to 4.30pm.

Derby teenager wins National Junior Handler of the Year title

A teenager from Derby has been awarded the title of National Junior Handler of the Year, making her the first in eleven years to win handling a Siberian Husky.

Paige Hughes, aged 15, was awarded the top spot by judge, Alex Paisey, at the prestigious final, organised by the Junior Handling Association (JHA), alongside her Siberian Husky Lexie (Ch Siberiadrift Keep Forever JW SHCM SHCEX OSW). Abbie Stoutt was the last competitor to win the National Junior Handler of the Year final with the breed in 2012.

The event took place alongside The Kennel Club's Junior Warrant of the Year semi-final, both held for the first time at The Kennel Club Building in Warwickshire on Sunday 22 October 2023. Paige, who has been a Young Kennel Club (YKC) member for nine years, will now represent the UK at the Joe Cartledge Memorial International Junior Handling Final held at Crufts 2024, on Friday 8 March, where the judge will be Rony Doedijns from The Netherlands.

More than 150 junior handlers competed in the JHA semi-final heats during 2023 with their chosen breeds, each attempting to win one of 14 places in the National Junior Handler of the Year final. In the second part of the competition, the top six competitors were then all given a Border Terrier to handle.

The final results of the National Junior Handler of the Year 2023 were:



WINNER: Paige Hughes, aged 15, handling Lexie, a Siberian Husky

RUNNER-UP: Edward Eddery, aged 17, handling Bianca, a Labrador Retriever (GCH/Ch Tampa Bay And Eagle Ponds Kisses Sweeter Than Wine)

3RD: Megan Slack, aged 15, handling Darcie, a Standard Poodle (Kamarri Born To Be Wild At Achara)

4TH: Maisie Allenby, aged 14, handling Rory, a Borzoi (Ch Ryazan Viceroy Of Radost At Menigma ShCEX)

5TH: Izzy King, aged 17, handling Etta, a Briard (Ch Barronoaks Etta Bagel)

6TH: Jess Smith, aged 17, handling Buffy, a Parson Russell Terrier (Alncroft Foxtrot)

Commenting on her win, Paige said: "Leading up to the event, I was extremely nervous but excited to be in the final again as I was lucky enough to be competing for the fourth time and it was my second time in the final with Lexie. Knowing Lexie would be foot perfect did help me to calm down.

"When the judge pointed at me, it felt incredible and it's still sinking in! I thought I was dreaming and I am still

smiling from ear to ear. My performance on the day felt like it was going well as Lexie was just being the best dog I could ever ask for. Lexie loved all the cheering from the audience and she loves competing with me."

Paige won her spot in the final by winning first place at the JHA semi-final heat in July 2023 at the National Working and Pastoral Breeds Society, held at Three Counties Showground in Malvern, under judge, Helen Taylor-Morris.

Paige is currently studying for her GCSEs and is considering a career in the police force as a dog handler. In addition to

competing in breed and handling competitions with her 14 Siberian Huskies and Dalmatian, in her spare time she also runs her Siberian Huskies in racing trials in the winter months. Last year, she competed in her first trek covering 30 miles over two days with seven of her Siberian Huskies.

The National Junior Handler of the Year final, organised by the Junior Handling Association, has been running since the 1970s and is one of the most hotly contested junior handling finals in the country. The semi-final heats for the 2023 competition took place between December 2022 and August 2023 at the national group championship shows.

Nominations open for major award that recognises outstanding young dog owners

The Young Kennel Club (YKC) is welcoming nominations for the Young Person of the Year award 2024, which will see five young dog lovers recognised at Crufts.

The annual award, which celebrates the dedicated, inspirational and selfless actions of young dog lovers is returning for 2024 and the YKC is calling on the friends and families of its members to put forward those that they believe are deserving of one of the five categories.

The categories are:

PERSONAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARD:

Celebrating young people who have overcome personal challenges, alongside their dog, as well as the skills they have developed to achieve success in 2023

SPORTING TALENT AWARD:

Celebrating young people who showed real passion and dedication for competing or training their dog/s in 2023

INSPIRING OTHERS AWARD:

Celebrating young people and their dogs who, through their positive attitude and inspirational approach, have proved to be a good role model in 2023

COMPASSION AWARD:

Celebrating young people who dedicate their time volunteering to help others, and have gone above and beyond expectations in 2023

COMMUNITY AWARD:

Celebrating young people who have shown commitment and passion through social action – fundraising, campaigning, activities at school, college or community – for the welfare of dogs in 2023

The award is a real celebration of our hard working and inspiring young members

Izzy King, aged 17, from Maidstone, Kent, won the 2023 award at Crufts earlier this year.

Izzy was diagnosed with a vascular malformation tumour in 2020, for which she is still undergoing treatment at Great Ormond Street Hospital. Not only affecting her physical health, the diagnosis had a huge impact on her mental health, and also resulted in her missing 60 per cent of school time. Despite all these setbacks, Izzy passed

all of her GCSEs and is currently studying A Levels, with the ultimate career goal of opening her own canine photography studio.

Izzy has been helped through her illness by MIND, and in 2021 she ran an online dog show, raising £2,100 for the charity to say thank you.

Helen Kerfoot, Interim Chief Operations Officer (Canine Activities) at The Kennel Club, said: "The YKC Young Person of the Year award is a real celebration of our hard working and inspiring young members, and the dedication towards their dogs that they have demonstrated this year, and we are so pleased to be recognising and rewarding them once again in 2024."

The closing date for nominations is 18 December, and the shortlisted nominees from each category will be announced in January before being put forward for a public vote for the overall winner, who will be announced at Crufts 2024 in March.

Official recognition of health tests

The Kennel Club has announced changes to accepted laboratories it will accept DNA results from in order to align with the changing landscape of the genetic testing industry.

The accuracy of the DNA test results recorded by The Kennel Club is crucially important for the integrity of its database, and consequently, for the quality of the advice given to breeders. The Kennel Club has undergone a consultation process with laboratories providing test results to develop the below criteria which all laboratories, both new and previously recognised must meet in order for DNA tests to be accepted.

- Laboratory is required to provide a certificate for current and valid specific ISO accreditation for the competence of testing and calibration, or a separately agreed equivalent of quality assurance certification issued by an independent monitoring body. Laboratories hosted by universities are exempt from this criteria.

- Laboratory is required to be a participant (or leadership sponsor) in the Harmonisation of Genetic Testing for Dogs project led by the International Partnership for Dogs.

- Laboratory is required to provide a full list of offered tests, together with the details of the mutation tested for, to ensure The Kennel Club is recording results for the intended mutation tested for. This is to minimise the risk that the results recorded under the same label by different laboratories refer to different genetic variants, which could have severe consequences should hereditary status be assigned based on the results held in The Kennel Club's database.

Joanna Ilska, Canine Geneticist at The Kennel Club said: "By implementing the new and improved process of accepting laboratories, we can ensure that the

laboratories we record results from work to consistently high levels of quality. This way we can be confident we have accurate records and are supporting breeders through best practice.

"We have worked hard to ensure all laboratories have been contacted, however in some instances have not always received feedback. We will continue to try and continue conversations with all and if a laboratory is not included on the revised list we would like to reassure that they are still able to re-apply at any time."

For laboratories which have been on the list of accepted laboratories to date, but do not appear on the revised list, there will be a grace period where The Kennel Club will continue to record their results until the end of 2023. However, as of 1 January 2024 (date of test result), the results from these laboratories will no longer be accepted into The Kennel Club's database. 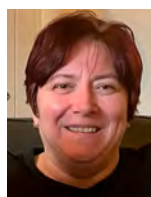

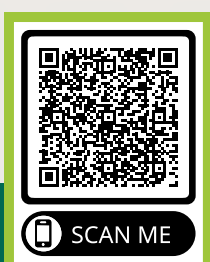
